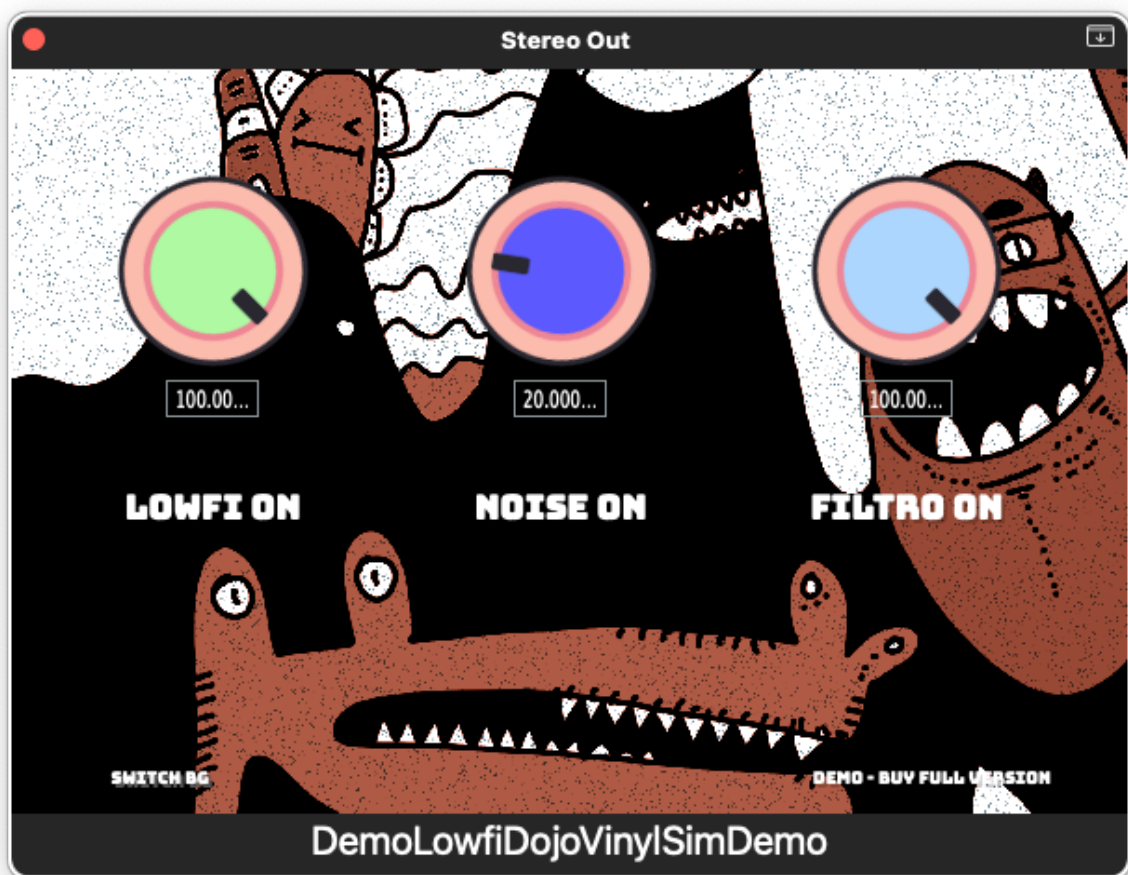


Lowfi Dojo Vinyl Simulator Plugin Demo for Mac + Win- dows



Manual Installation Guide

Thank you for trying the **Lowfi Dojo Vinyl Simulator** plugin demo! Below are the instructions for installing the plugin on macOS and Windows.

macOS Installation (AU and VST3)

1. **Download the plugin** and unzip the provided file.
2. **For AU (Audio Unit):**
3. Copy the `.component` file to the following directory:
`/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components/`
4. If the folder is locked, you may need administrator permissions. Simply drag and drop the file and enter your password when prompted.
5. **For VST3:**
6. Copy the `.vst3` file to the following directory:
`/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3/`
7. As with AU, you may need to enter your administrator password.
8. **Restart your DAW** and **rescan for plugins** (check your DAW's manual on how to rescan if needed).
9. **Plugin location:**
10. AU: Should be listed under "Audio Units."
11. VST3: Should be listed under "VST3 Plugins."

Windows Installation (VST3)

1. **Download the plugin** and unzip the provided file.
2. **For VST3:**
3. Copy the .vst3 file to the following directory:
`C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3\`
4. You may need to confirm administrator permissions to complete this step.
5. **Restart your DAW** and **rescan for plugins** (check your DAW's manual on how to rescan if needed).
6. **Plugin location:**
VST3: Should be listed under "VST3 Plugins."

Demo Version Limitations

This demo version of the **Lowfi Dojo Vinyl Simulator** plugin has the following limitation:

- The plugin works for **60 seconds** and then stops processing audio. You will need to restart your DAW session to reset the plugin's timer and try it again.
- Note: Everything else in your DAW project will continue to work as normal; only the **Lowfi Dojo Vinyl Simulator** plugin will stop working after the 60-second trial period.

Features

Clickable Text Labels for Effect Control

The **Lowfi Dojo Vinyl Simulator** introduces clickable text labels for toggling the effects on or off. The **FILTER**, **NOISE**, and **LOWFI** labels located beneath each knob are now clickable. You can turn the respective effects on or off by simply clicking the text, without needing additional buttons or switches, making the interface even more user-friendly.

- **FILTER**: Toggle the low-pass or high-pass filter.
- **NOISE**: Activate or deactivate the noise effect.
- **LOWFI**: Enable or disable the tape saturation and resampling effect for a classic low-fidelity sound.

Linear Slider Control

In addition to the rotary control, you can now access a linear drag mode for all sliders by holding down the **Alt/Option** key on macOS or the **Command** key on Windows, together with the **Shift** key. This allows for smooth vertical slider adjustments instead of the default rotary motion.

Switchable Background Designs

The **Lowfi Dojo Vinyl Simulator** plugin features four unique background designs that you can switch between at any time. Use the **Switch BG** button to cycle through the backgrounds, adding a dynamic visual element to your experience.

How to Access the Hidden Library Folder on macOS

Some plugin installation paths require access to the hidden Library folder. Follow these steps to access it:

1. Open Finder.
2. In the menu bar, click on **Go**.
3. Hold down the **Option (Alt)** key. You should now see Library appear in the dropdown menu.
4. Click on **Library** to open it.

Once inside the Library folder, navigate to the appropriate path to install the plugin:

- **Audio Units (AU):** Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components
- **VST3:** Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST3
